



CRI SITRUSNAVORSINGSIMPOSIUM 2016

Die 2014 CRI Sitrusnavorsingsimposium is so pas verby. Dit was 'n gulde geleentheid vir sitrusprodusente en verwante bedrywe om op hoogte te kom van die afgelope twee jaar se navorsings-resultate en het aan die 580 kongresgangers die geleentheid gegee om industrie aangeleenthede informeel te bespreek en om gesellig saam te verkeer. Vyf en vyftig lesings is aangebied, daar was sowat 40 plakkate en meer as 60 borge het blootstelling aan die bedryf gekry.

Die vraag is waar en wanneer die volgende symposium gehou moet word. Soos in die verlede het die simposiumgangers oorweldigend vir Champagne Sports Resort in Augustus 2016 gestem. Dit bly 'n uitstekende venue wat 600+ simposiumgangers in die lesingsaal kan akkomodeer, twee sale het vir die silver en goue borge vir uitstellings en 'n derde saal het vir die gala-ete wat 510 mense kan akkomodeer. Daar is ook een van die beste golfbane in Suid Afrika.

CRI se bekommernis is egter daardie produsente wat nie die geleentheid benut om hierdie prestige geleentheid by te woon nie. Ons glo dat ons saam 'n beter sitrusindustrie kan bou en wil daarom aan elke sitrusprodusent of verwante organisasie wat nie die 8ste CRI Sitrusnavorsingsimposium bygewoon het nie die geleentheid gee om die 9de CRI Sitrusnavorsingsimposium in 2016 by te woon. Die venue en die tyd van die jaar sal nooit al die produsente pas nie. CRI poog om dit so te hou, dat die nuutste navorsings resultate voor die symposium ingesamel en verwerk kan wees, maar dat die symposium gehou word voor die aanvang van die Lente-plaagkompleks. Indien die bespuitingseisoen eers begin het sal aansienlik minder produsente die simposium kan bywoon en geen van die sitruskonsultante nie.

CRI CITRUS RESEARCH SYMPOSIUM 2016

The 2014 Citrus Research Symposium has come and gone. This symposium served as an excellent opportunity for citrus producers and relevant industries to keep abreast with the last two years' research results and afforded the 580 symposium delegates the opportunity to interact with each other on a social and academic level. Fifty-five lectures were presented, 40 posters were exhibited and more than 60 sponsors were given the opportunity of exhibiting their products to the industry.

The question now raised is where and when is the next symposium going to be held? As in the past, an overwhelming number of votes were received from symposium delegates wishing to hold the symposium at Champagne Sports Resort (CSR) in 2016. CSR remains an excellent venue and can accommodate 600+ symposium delegates in the lecture hall, there are two halls available for the Gold and Silver sponsors' exhibitions, and a third hall is available to accommodate 510 gala dinner guests. CSR also has one of the best golf courses in South Africa.

One of CRI's concerns is those producers who do not make use of this opportunity to attend this prestigious event. We believe that if we all work together we can build a better citrus industry and we therefore appeal to citrus producers who did not attend the 8th Citrus Research Symposium to please make an effort to attend the 9th Citrus Research Symposium in 2016. CRI is aware of the fact that the venue and timing of our symposia will never suit all producers but we do endeavour to gather and process the latest research results and to communicate these to the symposium delegates before the commencement of the Spring Pest Complex Workshops. At the commencement of the spray season, less growers and citrus consultants will be able to attend the symposium.

By die goedkoper fasiliteite sal daar minder uitstalruimte wees vir die borge en waarskynlik geen gholfdag of gala-ete nie wat sal beteken dat heelparty van die simposiumborgie waarskynlik sal onttrek omdat hulle nie die nodige blootstelling sal kry nie. Die venue moet egter steeds 600 simposiumgangers kan akkommodeer. **The less costly venues will mean that there will be fewer display areas for the sponsors and probably no Golf day or Gala dinner resulting in symposium sponsors withdrawing because of insufficient exposure. The venue must be able to accommodate 600 delegates.**
